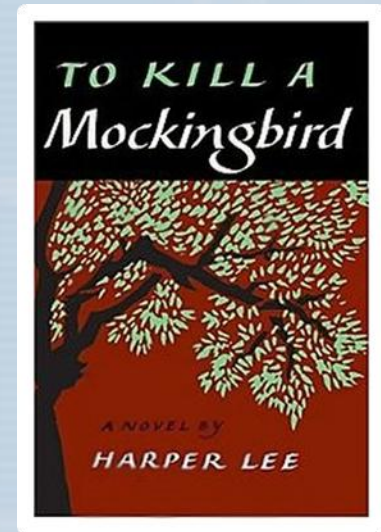
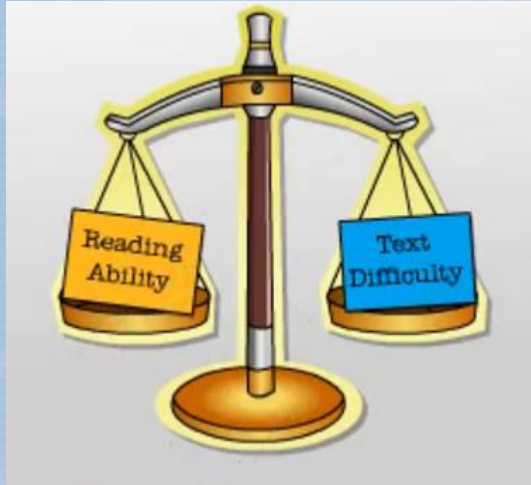
A Lexile is a measure of both **reading level** and **text complexity**, *on the same scale.*

2 What is a Lexile?

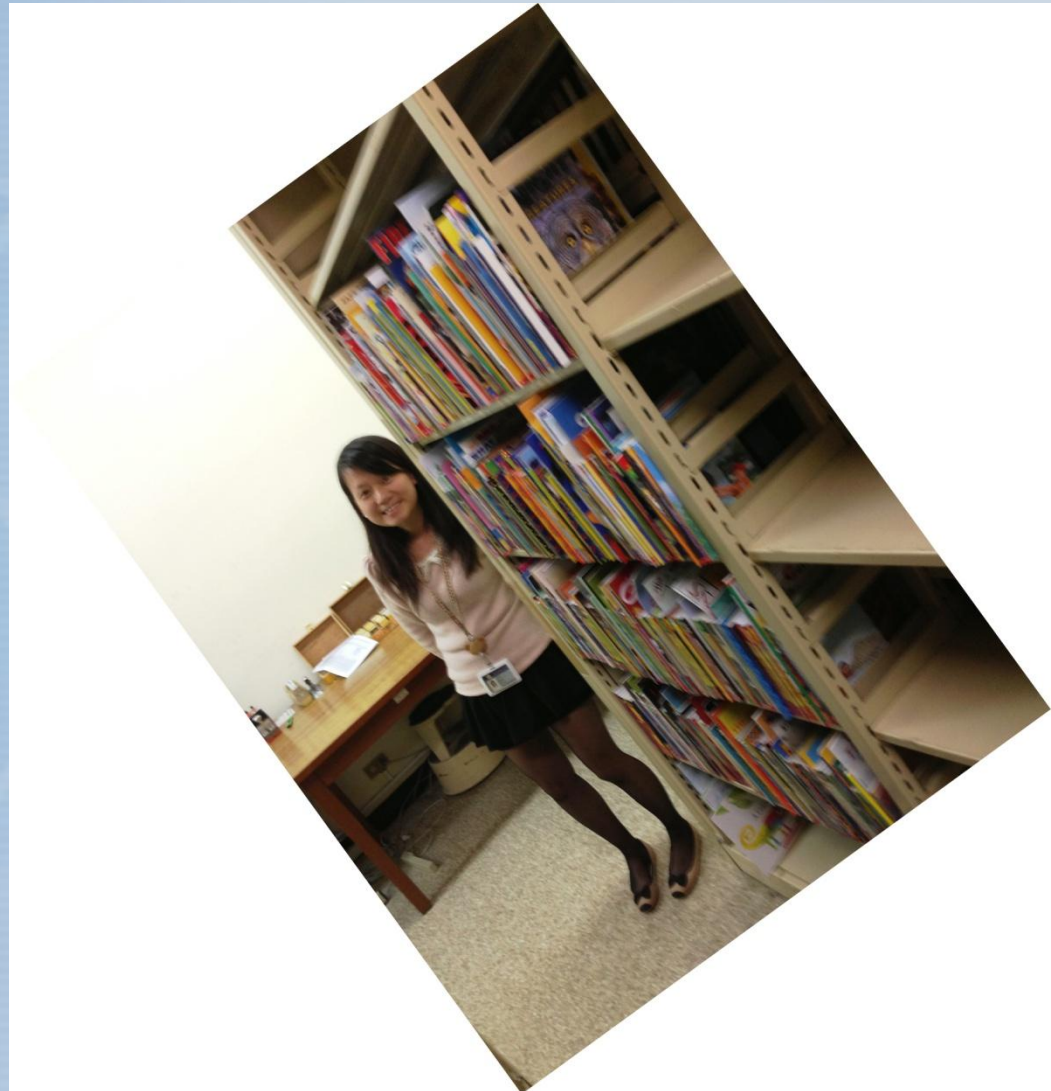
- A lexile is a unit of measurement used when determining the difficulty of text and the reading level of readers.

3 What is a Lexile range?

- - It is the suggested range of Lexile at which a reader should be reading. You can read the range of 50 above and 100 below of the Lexile index.
- - Ex : If your Lexile index is 820, it means you can understand 75% of the book of Lexile 820. You can read books of Lexile ranged 720~870

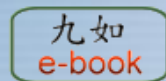
