英文閱讀

「閱讀的歷程，是一個心理語言的猜測遊戲」
(Goodman, 1998)

閱讀不僅僅是由下往上的辨識過程(bottom-up processing) 也是由上而下的猜測過程(top-bottom processing)，不要只強調辨識讀音、單字或句型也要給孩子自己推測文意的機會圖畫可以說明沒有基礎的孩子瞭解故事的內容在有意義的語意情境中去猜測文意的閱讀過程。

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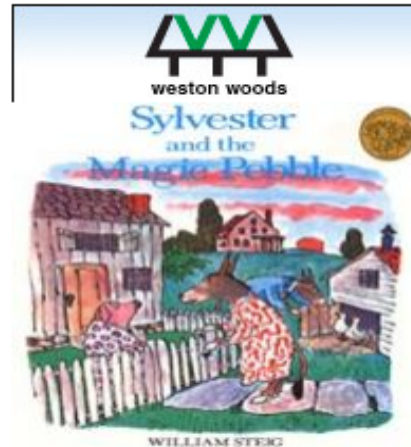
